- 4. **Harvest Horse Show:** Ashley Woodhouse Slade could not access to the necessary financial data and had difficulty filing the 1099 forms. The Canadian rider whose check that bounced twice is unresponsive. Ashley Woodhouse Slade will submit it to the USHJA and Canadian Governing Body.
- 5. **Year End Awards:** It was decided to add 3'3" Junior Hunter to the Year End Awards program and keep other divisions as they were for 2014. Small Hunters and Thoroughbred Hunters and Jumpers will also be added to the Year End Awards program. They will follow the USEF specifications. There was discussion around eligibility requirements for Year End Awards For Hunters and Jumpers, a horse must show in the division at three MHJA approved horse shows for points to count towards year end awards in that division. For Equitation MHJA year end awards the rider must show in the division three times for points to count. Division Hunter Classics will not count towards year end awards. All ties for hunters will be determined by the horse with the most points over fences.
