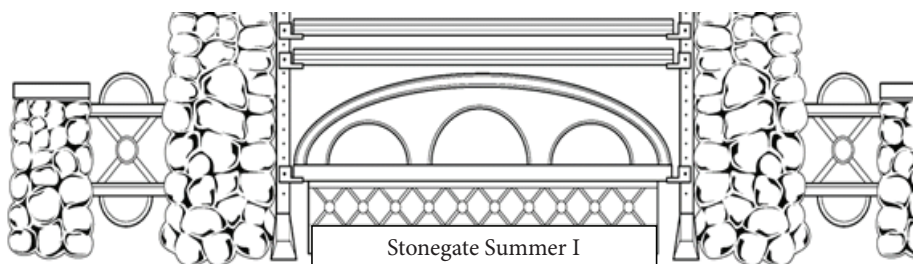

RULES AND REGULATIONS

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith"

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

CONDITION OF ENTRY: The Stonegate Farm and the MHJA, its officers, agents or employees, will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it will be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold the Horse Show and its management blameless for any loss or accident to his/her animal or equipment. The show will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to participants, spectators, employees or any other party.

The Stonegate Farm Summer I horse show and the MHJA Hunter horse show reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and to cancel award prizes without claim for damages, to change courses, to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors.

In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

RESPONSIBILITY: All owners, exhibitors and vendors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and horses, to stalls, buildings and other property on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS: Show management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to retain any fee before or during the show without liability. Further, it reserves the right to do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulters or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. ("the Federation") and the local rules of the Stonegate Summer I and MHJA competitions. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

I have carefully read this document in its entirety, understand all of its terms and conditions, and know it contains an assumption of risk, release and waiver from liability, as well as a hold harmless and indemnification obligations.

REFUNDS: Prior to the start of the show, entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by a veterinarian or a medical doctor in case of a rider, stating that the horse/rider is unable to perform in the classes entered. Once the horse has shown, show management will accept a statement from the official horse show veterinarian only. Refund requests must be submitted to the show secretary prior to completion of show.

RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$30.00 office charge for any checks returned by a bank for any reason. In the event a check is returned after the show's completion, it will be handled in accordance with USEF rules and regulations.

PREMIUM CHECKS: Premium checks may be picked up at the secretary's office after bill has been paid in full. ***PREMIUMS CAN BE SUBTRACTED FROM PAYMENT DUE.***

MEDICAL WASTE: All needles and syringes **MUST** be deposited in designated disposal containers and not left in stalls or thrown in trash receptacles.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS: Eight ribbons will be offered in every class, unless specified. Championships and reserves will be awarded according to GR 808 for hunters, and JP 110.2 for jumper and equitation divisions.

PROTESTS: Any USEF member exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit \$200.00 with any member of the show committee, the show manager, or show secretary, which sum shall be forfeited if same is not sustained (non-member fee is \$300). All protests must be made in writing, signed by the protester, and filed with any member of the show committee, the show manager the show secretary, or The Federation Hearing Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation. Please be aware that a protest can also be filed with the Federation Hearing Committee up to 10 days after your competition. If the protest is sustained the entries standing next in award will be moved up accordingly. See GR 603

DOG OWNERS USEF GR1301.6. Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7.

BACK-TO BACK CLASSES: Where two classes from a division are shown in consecutive order in the schedule (back-to back), the exhibitor may remain in the ring after completing the course for the first class and immediately ride and be judged in the next class. Those who prefer, may exit the ring after the first class and return for the next class in the posted order unless otherwise provided for by the paddock master.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW: DECLARE ALL CLASSES the day before classes are held. A **TRANSACTION FEE** will be charged at **\$5.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET** if changes are made on the same day as the classes are held.

ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS WITHOUT HAVING FILLED OUT THE PAPERWORK, WILL BE CHARGED A \$10.00 FEE EACH TIME.

COURTESY CIRCLE: In all classes, the courtesy circle may be restricted and if so, will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. Announcement to this effect will be at least one hour prior to implementation.

ORDER OF GO: Show management will determine a rotating order of go using a computer. Riders who have a conflict should report to the paddock master. Order of go will be posted in the paddock area.

ATTIRE: Riders must be neatly attired when competing. Any person not suitably attired may be barred at the discretion of the show management. USEF Rule HU157 & JP103: The use of any device with ear bud(s) while mounted is prohibited in all hunter and jumper schooling rings.

ATTENTION

PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES WITHIN 12 MONTHS. THIS IS A STATE LAW. PROOF OF FLU/RHINO VACCINATION WITHIN 6 MONTHS MUST BE PRESENTED PER USEF. THESE MUST BE PRESENTED BEFORE NUMBERS WILL BE GIVEN OUT.

Vaccination Requirements (per the USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule [CHAPTER 8F Welfare of the Horse] Rule Changes Effective 12/1/15)

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

See USEF Rules GR 1101, 1102. All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form **HORSES MUST STILL BE RECORDED WITH THE USEF (EITHER LIFETIME OR ANNUAL) TO RECEIVE NATIONAL OR ZONE POINTS.** See USEF Rules EQ 100.2, HU 101.1, And JP 100.2.

□ Microchip: Beginning December 1, 2018, all horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Eq competitions must have a USEF-approved Microchip on file with USEF. Horses will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met. HU 104

GOLF CARTS & MOTORIZED VEHICLES

USEF Rule GR1301 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/ legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/ jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the

playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. **See USEF GR 801.**

SAFETY: Accidents Involving Competitors. GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

NON-SHOWING HORSE - A horse may be entered as "NONSHOWING" on the original entry form at the time the entry blank is submitted by writing "Non-Showing" in the area of the entry blank where classes would normally be entered. An Official "Non- Showing Horse" is required to pay the stall fee and a \$125.00 Non-Showing Fee in addition to the Office Fee.

MEMBERSHIP/MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS:

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$45 USEF (or \$75 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable show pass fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries. Entry forms will not be accepted unless signed by the owner or his authorized agent, coach and trainer and accompanied by a check.

Please include your USEF/USHJA membership number and the USEF/USHJA number of your trainer and coach on all entry forms. In filling out entry blanks, please give complete name and addresses of all owners. Anyone under 18 years of age must have a signature of a parent or responsible person over 18 years of age. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERSON MAKING THE ENTRY TO EXECUTE PROPERLY AND COMPLETE ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO EACH ENTRY MADE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF THE USEF.** No numbers will be released until proper credentials and signatures are in order.

☐ Safe Sport: Beginning December 1, 2018, All Senior members of USEF will be required to complete a Safe Sport training class at USEF.org before competing in a USEF Licensed competition. An exhibitor will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.

MICRO CHIPPING

Beginning in the 2018 competition year, all horses competing in USEF-licensed and/or USHJA-sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper, and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed will be required to be microchipped to receive points. The following year, 2019, this will be a requirement for all horses competing in these classes. USEF has provided education materials to competitors to learn more about microchipping and the rules (HU101, JP100, EQ103).

JUMPERS: A Rotating pre-posted jumping order will be established in all classes and posted in the paddock area at least one-half hour before the class is to begin. Any horse schooling except over the designated practice jumps shall be disqualified. Jumps and courses in any or all classes are subject to change at the discretion of the committee, in the case of a jump-off, damage to equipment or for any other reason. 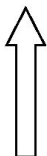

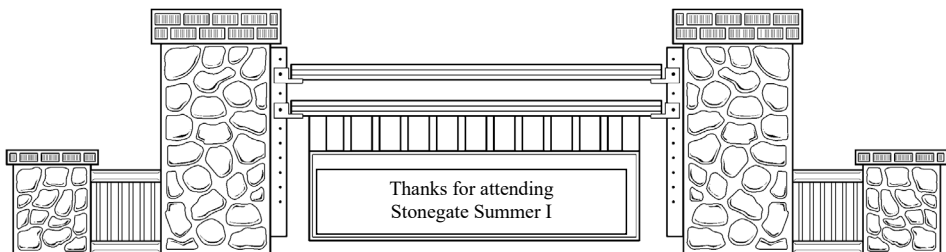

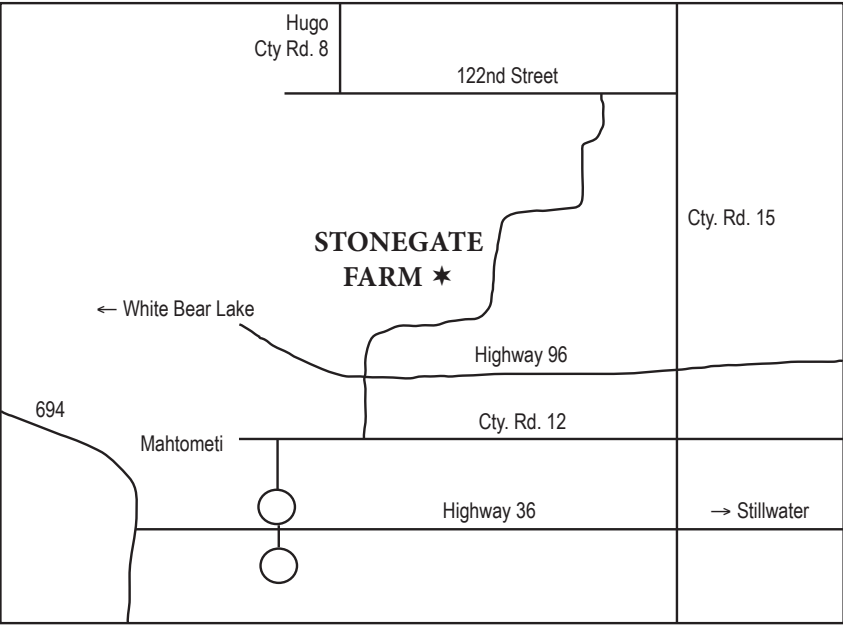

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the “Released Parties” or “Event Organizers”**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature (“**Liability**”) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.
